- 1) Please complete and submit page 2 along with the proper payment on or before **Friday, December 21, 2018**. *Please note: all applications received after this date will be accessed a **\$25.00 LATE FEE**. Completed applications along with your payment may be dropped off in the mailbox outside the Learn to Skate office door or in the Main office during office hours: Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- 2) All skaters will pay the established application fee. The application fees are listed on page 2.
- 3) Ice Show information will be sent via email AND posted on the Learn to Skate office windows.
- 4) If you would like to be in a GROUP NUMBER with a friend, both skaters should be the same level AND close to the same age. Both skaters must submit their applications together and attach a note requesting to be in the same Group number. We will do our best to honor your request. Final Group placement will be determined by the Ice Show Director.
- 5) The Ice Show Rehearsal Schedule should not conflict with your skater's class schedule, however, in the likely hood that it does your skater should attend their show rehearsal and we will offer a make-up class for their missed lesson.
- 6) Ice Show Rehearsals will be held between: Thursday, April 11, 2019 – Thursday, May 9, 2019.

It is important for skaters to attend the majority of their rehearsals. Most groups will have five (5) to six (6) one hour rehearsals. Skaters need to feel prepared for their show performance...practice makes perfect!
- 7) Ice Show Pictures will be taken on Monday, April 15, 2019 and Tuesday, April 16, 2019. Ice Show Picture Packages will be available for purchase through Masserman Photo. You will receive a detailed Picture Day schedule as well as an order form via email at the end of March. Ice Show photos are placed in the commemorative Ice Show Program, which will be available for purchase.
- 8) Group assignments and costume pictures will be posted on the Learn to Skate Office window in mid-January.
- 9) The first half of the Ice Show is generally 60 minutes with a 25 minute intermission followed by the second half at 60 minutes...making the entire production approximately two and a half hours long. All skaters are encouraged to be in the GRAND FINALE that takes place at the end of each performance.
- 10) **Opening number information:** All skaters in the show may choose to participate in the Opening number. There will **NOT** be an additional charge, however, there will be additional rehearsal time required.

MEASUREMENTS (ALL SKATERS INCLUDING HIGH SCHOOL):

Use a cloth tape, record accurate results (INCHES), Leave minimal room for growth.

Please Note: Measure from the highest point of the right shoulder, down between the legs and back up to the right shoulder. Make a complete circle with the tape measure. Girth will be the **BIGGEST** measurement. Basically the circumference of your skater's torso.

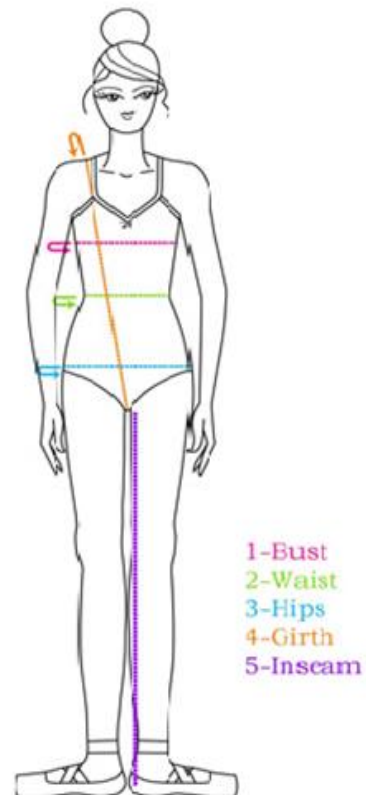

Getting the Measurements:

- **Bust/Chest** – Measure over the fullest part of the chest having the dancer's arms relaxed at their sides.
- **Waist** – Measure around where the waist naturally indents. Keep your finger between the tape and their belly.
- **Hips** – Measure around the fullest part of the hips and buttocks while your dancer stands with their heels together.
- **Girth** – Measure from the midpoint on the shoulder towards the front, through the crotch and back around to meet the midpoint of the shoulder.
- **Inseam** – Measure from the crotch to the bottom. The inseam length is the number of inches, to the nearest half-inch.
