

Lincoln Street & Shirley near the Linden Park Trail. The meeting will begin at 12:00 p.m. Approved minutes of this meeting will be available at the Clerk's Office or www.bhamgov.org/commission.

This notice is subject to change dependent on inclement weather. Pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, MCL 15.263.(1) ALL meetings of a public body must be open to the public and must be held in a place available to the general public. Michigan law and courts have held that a public body must make its decisions in public, deliberate in public and in a place accessible to the public. If the weather is a danger to health and safety, as declared by the Fire Chief, or a weather advisory is issued, then the outdoor public meeting would NOT be accessible to the general public, and as a result the meeting would need to be re-scheduled to the alternate date of Saturday, January 20, 2024 at 3:00 p.m. Please watch the Birmingham City
