City of Birmingham Participates in the Detroit Institute of Arts' Inside | Out Program



BIRMINGHAM, MI, June 22, 2022 – Masterpieces from the Detroit Institute of Arts' (DIA) collection are on display throughout the City of Birmingham during the DIA's Inside | Out program. Now in its 13th year, the Inside | Out program brings high-quality reproductions of the DIA's collection to outdoor venues throughout metro Detroit to increase engagement between the museum and its diverse audience.

Six replicas are now on display outdoors throughout the City of Birmingham through November. Keep an eye out for art installations near the Baldwin Public Library, Birmingham City Hall, Booth Park, Birmingham Bloomfield Art Center (BBAC) and Shain Park.

The City of Birmingham has participated in the Inside | Out program in prior years. Highlights for this year's program include *The Lily Pond* by Charles Harry Eaton, *Portrait of Postman Ruolin* by Vincent Van Gogh, *Animals in Landscape* by Franz Marc and more! The high-profile program is expected to generate excitement and increase foot traffic in the downtown area.
