Birmingham to Hold South Eton Construction Project Open House

BIRMINGHAM, MI, January 6, 2023 – The public is invited to attend a South Eton Construction Project Open House event on Tuesday, January 17, 2023 from 6:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. at the Department of Public Services, located at 851 South Eton. Attendees may park inside the gate and use the side entrance. The construction project will take place on South Eton Street between 14 Mile Road and Yosemite Boulevard beginning in the spring of 2024.

"Open house attendees will have an opportunity to learn about next year's South Eton construction project, ask questions and review concept renderings," said City Engineer Melissa Coatta. "We encourage the public to join us and share their valuable feedback."

Event attendees will learn how to participate in an upcoming survey as city planners and engineers kick off planning for the 2024 project. A variety of design concepts will be on display and attendees may come and go at any time throughout the event.

"Representatives from the city's design consultant, MKSK, will be in attendance and available to discuss design concepts with attendees," said Senior Planner Brooks Cowan. "We want to emphasize this is a convenient walk-in, open house style format and we look forward to seeing everyone."

MKSK is a collective of planners, urban designers and landscape architects based out of Detroit. MKSK previously worked with the City of Birmingham on projects such as the award-winning phases of infrastructure improvements throughout the downtown area.
