

Household Hazardous Waste

The City of Birmingham is a community participant in the South Oakland County Resource Recovery Authority (SOCRRA) as a way to advocate proper recycling and disposal of harmful waste. Harmful substances to humans, animals, and the environment have a detrimental impact if proper disposal is neglected.

The following categories summarize acceptable household hazardous waste (HHW) items collected by SOCRRA:

- Automotive Products
- Cleaning Products
- Electronics
- Lawn and Garden Products
- Batteries
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Adhesives and Paints
- Medical Supplies

Please note that unlabeled containers, radioactive materials, and explosives are prohibited at SOCRRA facilities. The information listed below indicates the location and hours of operation for the nearest SOCRRA disposal facility.

- SOCRRA disposal location: 995 Coolidge, Troy, MI (between 14 Mile Road and Maple Road)
- Hours for Recycling, Trash Disposal, and Yard Waste Services: Monday through Friday 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
