Birmingham's Park Street Parking Structure Restoration Project Complete

BIRMINGHAM, Mich., September 19, 2014 – The City of Birmingham's Park Street Parking Structure restoration project has concluded. The structure, which offers 811 parking spaces, is now completely open and accessible. Beginning next week, the Ferndale entrance will be closed for reconstruction but the structure will be accessible via the Park Street entrance.

The project began in April and included concrete patching and waterproofing on Levels 2 and 3, and asphalt repair work on Level 1. With the restoration work complete, 250 parking spaces are once again available for use and Central Parking will be issuing 129 monthly parking passes.
