

REFUSE COLLECTION

DON'T MISS A PICK UP - PLACE TRASH OUT EARLY

Trash collection begins promptly at 7 a.m., so be sure to place trash/recyclables/yard waste at the curb by 6:45 a.m. Route timing can change daily, so don't count on a regular pick-up time. Items may be placed at the curb no sooner than 7 p.m. on the preceding evening.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

When a holiday occurs on a weekday, regular pick-up dates may be delayed by one day. Holidays that may affect scheduled pick-up include **New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas.** When in doubt, put it out.

ACCEPTABLE CONTAINERS

- Cans - up to 32 Gallons
- Plastic Bags - at least 2 mils thick
- Container and contents - max 60 lbs

BULKY ITEMS

Bulky items - furniture, appliances, carpeting, etc - may be placed for pick-up along with normal refuse - subject to the following guidelines:


- Wood fencing should be left in panels, no larger than 4 feet - maximum 5 panels per week
- Carpeting and padding must be rolled, tied, and no longer than 4'
- Refrigerator and freezer doors must be removed or tied closed
- No construction materials - concrete, brick, etc
- No logs, stumps or other bulky yard waste

If the item is too bulky for placement in the normal trash truck, crews will dispatch a separate truck.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

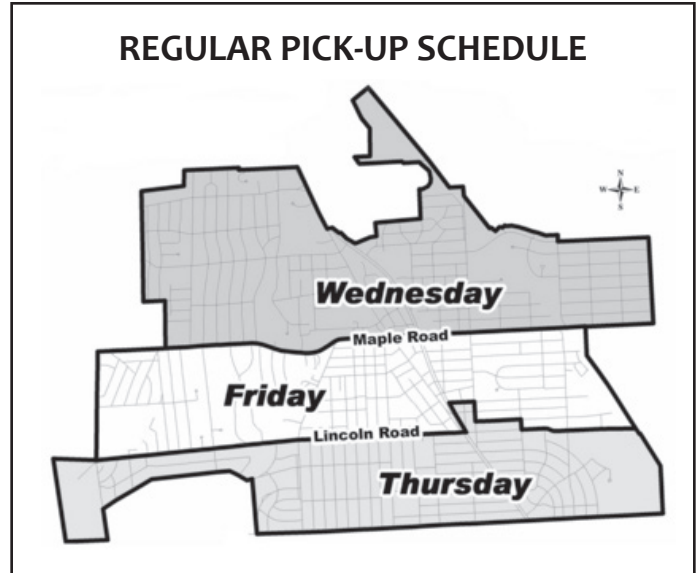
Motor oil, automotive batteries, paints, solvents, household cleaners, syringes and garden chemicals must be disposed of at the South-eastern Oakland County Resource Recovery Authority (SOCRRA) - no appointment necessary. For specific drop-off locations, call 248.288.5153

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Available 1st Monday of April through the 3rd Friday of December on normal refuse pickup schedule.

TWIGS, LEAVES, GRASS

- Place in brown, biodegradable paper yard bags or rigid container (up to 35 gallons) with a yard waste sticker affixed
- Stickers available at the DPS main office - 851 S. Eton - or the City Clerk's office located inside city hall - 151 Martin St.
- Yard waste WILL NOT BE COLLECTED OUTSIDE OF ESTABLISHED SEASON - PER STATE LAW
- During off-season, bagged waste (up to 10 bags) can be dropped off at the SOCRRA Material Recovery Facility - 995 Coolidge, Troy.

SMALL BRANCHES - Less than 2" in diameter and less than 4' long

- Available for weekly pick-up during spring/summer season
- Bundled and secured or placed in a yard waste bag
- NO logs or stumps

LARGE BRANCHES - Greater than 4' long, maximum 4" in diameter

- Stack branches along easement with cut ends facing the same direction
- Chipper truck is a separate service that may not coincide with normal refuse pick-up day
- March-Novemeber - no need to call; chipper truck cycles the city and chips large branches properly placed at curb
- Off-season: call 248.530.1700 for pick-up arrangements
