



### **Museum Researcher**

Museum Researchers assist in answering important questions for museum staff, visitors, city personnel, outside researchers, and others. They locate objects and/or information and may create documents or add to databases. They analyze information and help communicate it to museum staff and the general public. They work with the Museum Director and museum staff on special research projects, as well.

#### Duties include:

- Research documents, information, photos, objects, or books to answer particular questions
- Analyze and report findings verbally and/or in writing to museum staff
- Add information to electronic database as appropriate
- Develop and present information to the public, as appropriate
