Amorous couple cited for disorderly conduct

On Thursday, August 1, 2019 at approx. 12:17 a.m., a Birmingham police officer returning to the station from his patrol duties noticed a vehicle backed into a "Municipal Vehicles Only" section of the City Hall parking lot. Upon further inspection, the officer noted that the vehicle's windows were fogged and he could see the glow of interior dash lights.

The officer approached the vehicle and noted that there was no one in the front seats. The officer located two subjects in the rear seat of the vehicle in various stages of dress in an amorous moment. The officer alerted the subjects to his presence and asked that they exit the vehicle.

The officer cited the couple, a 24-year-old man of Clinton Township, MI and a 25-year-old female from Sterling Heights, MI, for disorderly conduct. The two are slated to appear in court on August 14, 2019 at 48th District Court.
