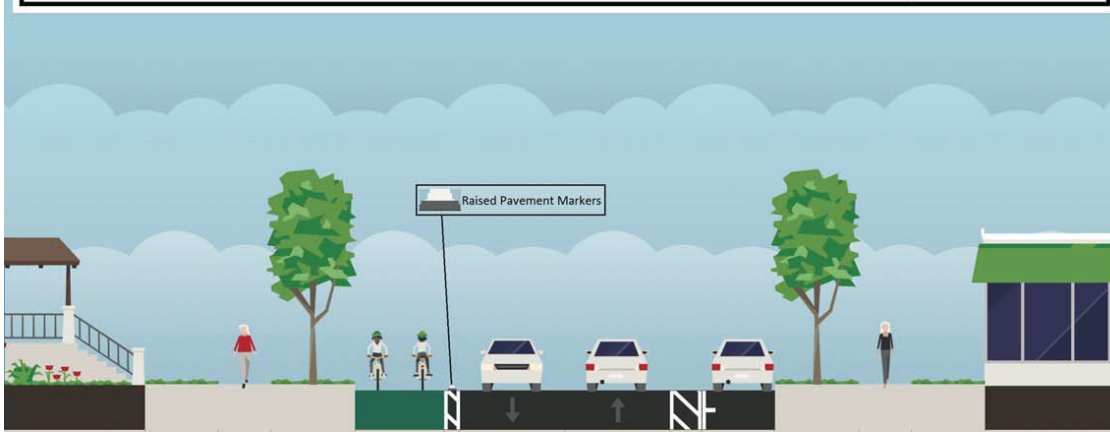


S. Eton Restriping

S. Eton Street (Lincoln to Villa)-Looking North



About

Maple Rd. to Yosemite Blvd.

- Installation of sharrows in both directions.

Yosemite Blvd. to Villa Ave.

- Removal of on-street parking on the street's west side. Installation of bike lanes and buffers for both directions of travel.

Villa Ave. to Lincoln Ave.

- Removal of on-street parking on the street's west side.
- Installation of a parking lane buffer.
- Installation of crosswalks at Villa, Hazel, Bowers (with flashing beacons), Holland, and Cole.
- Delineators will mark the beginning and end of on-street parking at each intersection.

Lincoln Ave. to 14 Mile Rd.

- Addition of a double yellow centerline and a white line for the parking lane.
- Installation of crosswalks at Melton, Sheffield, Bradford, and 14 Mile.
- Delineators will mark the beginning and end of on-street parking at each intersection.
- Installation of sharrows in both directions.

Reason

The City's Multi-Modal Transportation Plan recommends buffered bike lanes and crosswalks on S. Eton to help cyclists and pedestrians traverse and access the Rail District more safely.

Benefits

The project is intended to reduce speeding, and improve the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists using the corridor.

When

The work is scheduled to begin the week of May 20, 2019, depending on the weather. If the weather is not conducive, the work will be delayed. Once the work begins, it is expected to take about **one week** to complete. Traffic will be maintained throughout.
